CHARTER FLIGHT: 8D 5N JAPAN

Day 1 MALAYSIA

Gather at KLIA2 and depart for Osaka

Day 2 KYOTO TOUR

Arrive at Kansai International Airport (KIX) and meet the friendly Japanese driver and tour guide. Travel by private coach to Kyoto and visit Kiyomizudera, a well-known traditional area with historic streets and shops. Walk through Ninenzaka and take photos at the iconic Hokanji Pagoda. Continue to Kyoto shopping street with halal food options, then proceed to Kyoto Islamic Center for Zuhr and Asr prayers and halal lunch. Next, head to Arashiyama to visit Togetsukyo Bridge, with free time for photos, shopping, or a rickshaw ride. Enjoy a relaxing walk through the beautiful Arashiyama Bamboo Grove near Tenryuji Temple. Later, transfer to Osaka for hotel check-in and rest. Accommodation in Osaka, private transport provided, dinner included.

Day 3 NARA TOUR

Enjoy breakfast before continuing the tour by train to Nara, a city famous for its friendly deer roaming freely in the park. You will have the opportunity to interact with the deer by feeding them and taking photos. Enjoy the park scenery, try matcha ice cream (own expense), and shop for souvenirs. Next, proceed to a halal restaurant for lunch and prayers. The tour continues to Namba, a popular shopping area with many halal food options. Don't miss the chance to try authentic Japanese takoyaki. Free time is provided for photos at Dotonbori and shopping.

Day 4 OSAKA TOUR, BULLET TRAIN EXPERIENCE

After breakfast, check out from the hotel. Luggage will be sent directly to the Tokyo hotel at the participant's own expense and will be received the following evening, so please prepare an overnight bag for the stay in Fuji and the Fuji tour the next day. The tour continues to Osaka Bay to enjoy a ride on the Tempozan Ferris Wheel, offering panoramic views of Osaka from 112 meters above ground. Next, experience the Santa Maria Cruise, a 30-minute sightseeing cruise around Osaka Bay. Stop at Tempozan Mall for prayers and lunch, then proceed to Osaka Castle, a reconstructed historic landmark and iconic symbol of the city, where you may stroll around the grounds or enter the castle. In the afternoon, enjoy a memorable journey on Japan's bullet train from Shin-Osaka to Shin-Fuji, traveling at high speed while enjoying scenic views along the way. Upon arrival in Shin-Fuji, check in to the hotel and rest.



Day 5 FUJI TOUR

Don't miss the chance to witness the breathtaking view of Mount Fuji for the first time. From mid-April to end of May, visit the Fuji Shibazakura Festival at Lake Motosu, featuring stunning purple Shibazakura flower fields with Mount Fuji as the backdrop. Continue to Iyashi no Sato, a traditional Japanese village with thatched-roof houses, perfect for photos and souvenir shopping. Enjoy the scenic mirror-like view of Lake Kawaguchi at Oishi Park, then stop at Kawaguchi Mosque for prayers and lunch. Proceed to Gotemba Premium Outlets for shopping before heading to Tokyo. Upon arrival, check in to the hotel and rest.

Day 6 FREE AND EASY DI TOKYO

After breakfast, enjoy a free and easy day to explore places of your choice at your own expense, including transportation and entrance fees if applicable. Three optional activities are available: Disneyland or DisneySea, where the Tour Leader will send participants as early as 7:00 a.m. and pick them up after 7:00 p.m. by mutual arrangement; an Odaiba tour guided by the Tour Leader, featuring attractions such as the Japanese Statue of Liberty, Rainbow Bridge, Decks Mall, Aqua City Mall, the Gundam Statue, and DiverCity Tokyo Plaza; or, during winter only, a visit to Gala Yuzawa Ski Resort via bullet train, stopping directly at the gondola station for access to the snowy area, where participants are free to enjoy snow activities. For the ski tour, the Tour Leader will not accompany participants but detailed guidance, including train ticket arrangements, will be provided.

Day 7 TOKYO TOUR

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and ensure no belongings are left behind. Proceed to Asakusa, a historic district that once served as the main city during the Edo period, and visit the famous Kaminarimon Gate with its giant lantern. Enjoy souvenir shopping along Nakamise Street and take photos with Tokyo Skytree, the world's tallest telecommunications tower, in the background. Continue to Ueno, known for its lively flea market area, with time to visit Hard Rock Café Ueno-Eki and shop at Ameyoko Street. Lunch and prayers will be at Ueno Okachimachi Mosque. Next, head to Akihabara, the famous electronics and gadget district. After the tour, transfer to Haneda International Airport, where the tour guide will assist with check-in before departure back to Malaysia.
